Education / Academic Qualifications

2008-08 - 2017-03 Oslo School of Architecture and Design - Ph.D. The thesis "Urban Environments of The Entrepreneurial City - From Aker Brygge to Tjuvholmen" explores the regeneration of industrial harbor and brownfield areas to properties primed for urban development along the urban waterfront of Oslo. The project revolves around an empirical study of Tjuvholmen and Aker Brygge, both privately operated waterfront development schemes, centrally located in the city. The goal was to explore how these inherently architectural projects was conceptualized, built and represented as "urban environments" within a particular model of political-economic conduct. Located at each side of what has been defined as the "neo-liberal" era in planning, politics and economic life, the PhD is an exploration of the dynamics of architecture and urban form within entrepreneurial forms of urban planning and governance, but also make out a detailed account of architect Niels Torp, and the architectural legacy of one of Norway's master architects of the late 20th century.
